He is regarded as a leading practitioner, achieving considerable success, in trials relating to rape and other serious sexual crime (against both adults and children), and internet pornography offences. In many cases, his clients face allegations by multiple complainants, or claims of historic sexual abuse. He has appeared in several major multi-defendant cases of grooming and abusing vulnerable children.

The following are examples of recent notable cases, in which I represented the defendant:

Notable Crime cases

R v Daniel Eastwood – Kingston Crown Court (2021)

Man acquitted of all charges relating to the rape of a mother and her daughter.

R v Jones – Croydon Crown Court (2021)

Man acquitted of serious sexual offences against his granddaughter, aged 11.

R v Patrick Osborne - Inner London Crown Court (2020)

Man acquitted of a series of historic sexual offences against his stepdaughter.

R v Oliver Mears – Guildford Crown Court (2018)

Oxford University student acquitted of rape, following failure by the Crown Prosecution Service to make proper disclosure of the complainant's diary.

R v Graham – Snaresbrook Crown Court (2018)

A middle-aged man was acquitted of the rape of his younger brother and sister, when he himself was aged 11.

R v Suleiman - Snaresbrook Crown Court (2017)

Uber driver acquitted of raping his female passenger at night, while she was asleep in his vehicle.
